At this event you may pick-up uniforms, sign-up for after school care through Kama'ana Kids (K-6 grades only) and turn in all other paperwork. Please note that we do not participate in the National School Lunch Program and therefore all meals are offered through our meal vendor, Hale Kelaoha, at a slightly subsidized cost. Families wishing to order breakfast (\$2.25 each) and lunch (\$2.50 each) for your keiki can make payments on this day as well. Further information will be available on July 14-15, 2011.
